

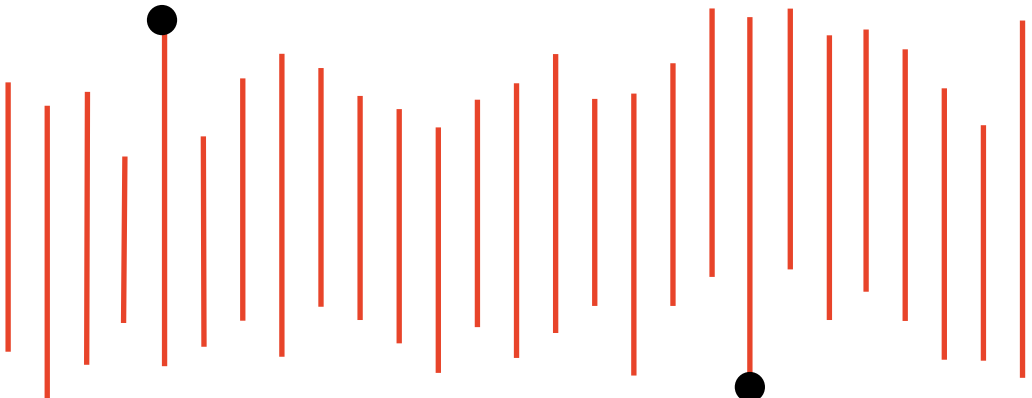

Brought together more than 200 key stakeholders across the financial services industry and government to raise the urgency of getting retirement income adequacy on the political agenda.



Held events from the Palace of Westminster to the fringes of the G20, WHO and UN assemblies, with Government Ministers and Embassies from the UK, US, Italy, Turkey, South Korea, Japan, Singapore and Saudi Arabia.



Helped inform the Tobacco and Vapes Bill by making the economic case for tighter regulation and progressive smoking age.



Hosted delegations of senior Government officials from South Korea, Singapore and Taiwan to inform their ageing strategies.
